Construction Dust - Much more than a nuisance!

Do you think that construction dust is just a nuisance? It is, in fact, a serious risk to construction workers. Regularly breathing even small amounts of dust over a long time can cause serious lung diseases, including cancer. Common jobs like cutting or grinding concrete, chasing out mortar, drilling in enclosed spaces or sanding wood/MDF can be high risk if not properly controlled.

This half day event and exhibition is aimed at managers, supervisors and operatives. It aims to raise awareness of the health problems caused by construction dust and the simple steps you should take to control it. 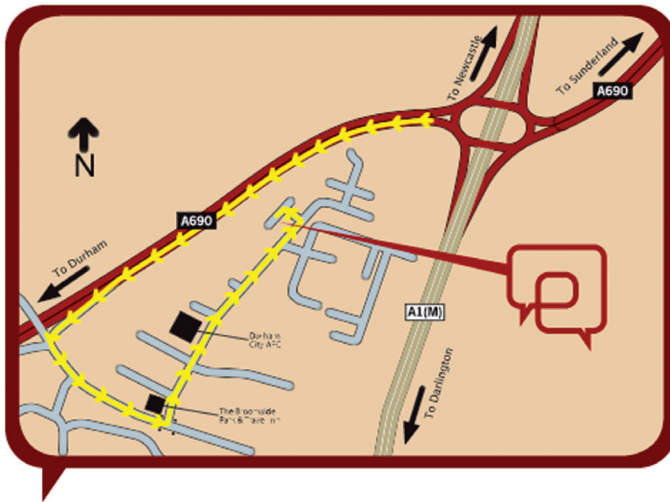

- Exit A1(M) at Junction 62, signposted Sunderland, Durham (A690), Consett (A691)
- At roundabout, take exit signposted Durham (A690), Consett (A691)
- Leave A690 at first exit, signposted Belmont, Dragonville, Karting Centre
- At Junction, turn left, signposted Belmont, Dragonville
- At traffic lights, turn left, signposted Belmont Business Park, Belmont Industrial Estate
- Continue for 1/2 mile, (past Carlsberg Distribution Centre)
- Turn left into Belmont Industrial Estate
- At junction, turn left
- The Durham Centre is on your right
