Asbestos related diseases are responsible for around 4500 deaths each year - the biggest single cause of work-related deaths in Great Britain. The number of deaths attributable to asbestos continues to rise and is not likely to peak for a few years. Although the use of asbestos is prohibited in new buildings, it is still present in buildings built or refurbished before the year 2000.

The Working Well Together West Midlands Group is offering FREE courses that will provide you with information on:

- ◆ the types, uses and likely occurrence of asbestos and asbestos containing materials (ACMs) in buildings and plant;
- ◆ the general procedures to be followed to deal with an emergency, e.g. an uncontrolled release of asbestos dust into the workplace;
- ◆ how to avoid the risks from asbestos, e.g. for building work, no employee should carry out work which disturbs the fabric of a building unless the employer has confirmed that ACMs are not present.
- ◆ the properties of asbestos and its effects on health, including the increased risk of lung cancer for asbestos workers who smoke.

The aims of these courses are to raise the awareness of individuals to the potential of asbestos exposure from their work activities in the construction industry.
